

COVID-19: Exiting Canada requirements checklist

As a visitor exiting Canada, here is what you need to prepare:

Before you travel

- Check for entry requirements for your destination country.
 - There are several COVID-19 vaccines from different countries around the world. Make sure that your destination country has approved your particular vaccine.
 - For a list of countries and their entry/exiting requirements, as well as travel advisories, visit [the Government of Canada's website](#).
- If you require COVID-testing as an entry requirement for your destination country:
 - Check the validity period of the pre-entry test result
 - Verify the type of tests approved by your destination country
 - Make sure to book in advance with an approved testing facility. Note that some testing facilities experienced a high volume of requests and tests may take up to 48 hours to be processed.
- Make sure you meet requirements to [board a flight in Canada](#) (e.g., not displaying COVID-19 symptoms)

COVID-19 Testing Required for U.S. Entry

- Effective January 26, the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](#) require all **air passengers*** two years of age and over entering the United States (including U.S. citizens and Legal Permanent Residents)
 - to present a negative COVID-19 test taken within three (3) calendar days of departure,
 - or proof of recovery from the virus within the last 90 days.
- Airlines must confirm the negative test result or proof of recent recovery for all passengers before boarding. Airlines must deny boarding of passengers who do not provide documentation of a negative test or recovery.

*Please note the requirements of this CDC order only apply to air travel into the US and does not apply to land border crossings.¹
